West Plains genetic influence continues to grow with over 50 Poll Merino studs Australia wide and internationally using our semen sires, stud rams and breeding ewes. Leading stud sire West Plains Mercenary's impact across flocks has seen him selected as one of two Industry Link Sires for the Lifetime Ewe Productivity Trial. Mercenary's offspring have grossed in excess of \$300,000 across Australia and overseas.

Our breeding aims are based on producing sires that improve commercial flocks bottom lines - more dollars per head. We use actual raw data: FW, micron, yield, style, BW, EMA and FAT. These are the traits we select for as this is what you, the customer, are actually paid on.

We select for large, structurally correct sires with long, deep bodies that result in more saleable meat which give greater returns. Our ewe base is also selected for length, width and depth to produce offspring that meet the needs of restockers.

In our wool types we prioritise length of staple and highly nourished wools that protect the fibre from rainfall and dust. We place emphasis on handle, whiteness and style. These wools consistently micron well and yield favourably.

Our ewe base are expected to thrive on grassland pastures and reproduce at a high rate. Our breeding strategies are to single mate all stud ewes to sires that complement them and to produce progeny which are predictable in type. ET programs are used to accelerate genetic progress. Our absolute highest performing ewes are mated to top industry sires to multiply rapidly the number of progeny from these outstanding females.





At West Plains they are true heavy cutting merino ewes that comb really well with white wools that are soft with near perfect fibre alignment, making them very water tolerant wools. Their extra crimp allows the wools to comb easier and there was no water staining or discoloured wools throughout the flock. They have soft supple skins that are productive but pliable. This paired with extra barrel in the body makes sheep easier to shear.'

INDUSTRY ACHIEVEMENT

Hinesville and West Plains use showing, objective measurement classes, sire reference trials and the saleyards to benchmark our breeding programs. These are some of the 2018 highlights:

- Sydney Royal 2018 Objective Measurement class Status Quo broke the all-time record for bodyweight at 161.3 kgs cutting 13.8 kgs at 19.7 micron with a 42 eye muscle. Status Quo won the 6 tooth Objective Measurement class.
- Australian Sheep and Wool Show Bendigo Two Up was awarded the Grand Champion Medium Wool Ram, horn or polled, of the show. International judge Michael Gough, Argentina presented us with the ribbon awarded to the Grand Champion ram of Argentina. This wool loomed ribbon will be very much treasured by our family.
- Dubbo National Two Up was Grand Champion Sale Ram, Supreme Merino Exhibit and NSW Ram of the Year. Two Up measured 18.2 micron and cut 14.6 kgs of wool. Two Up was sold to Edithvale Merino Stud, Finley for \$10,000 while retaining 50% semen marketing rights.

- Collinsville Stud, Hallet SA Collinsville won Grand Champion March Shorn Ram at Hay Sheep Show with a ram sired by West Plains Bushranger ET, a son of Mercenary.
- Orrie Cowie Stud, Warooka SA Sold Mercenary sons to \$15,000 with numerous Mercenary sons selling between \$6000 and \$9000. OC also exhibited the Champion Fine Wool March Shorn Ewe at Adelaide Royal, sired by Mercenary.

- Glendonald Stud, Nhill VIC Glendonald purchased Hinesville Dinkum for \$14,000. His first son was Champion Unhoused Ram at Hay and Bendigo.
- **Peter and Tania Tresidder, Culcairn NSW** Long time clients and friends, the Tresidder's 2017 wether lambs shore \$75 wool per head and the first run of 135 lambs made \$185 per head. This returned the Tresidder family \$260 per head.
- Wool Sales have seen numerous clients receive in excess of 2000 cents/kilogram greasy for wool sold this season.
